Founded in 1978, the Council on Naturopathic Medical Education is a tax-exempt, 501(c)(3), non-profit organization incorporated in Washington, D.C. CNME's mission is to promote high quality naturopathic medical education in the United States and Canada through the accreditation of four-year, primarily residential doctoral-level programs that lead to the Doctor of Naturopathy (ND) degree or diploma. Graduates of CNME-accredited and candidate programs are eligible to take the naturopathic licensing examinations administered by the North American Board of Naturopathic Examiners. The U.S. Secretary of Education recognizes CNME for preaccreditation and accreditation of ND programs in the U.S.

In February 2021, the Canadian College of Naturopathic Medicine (CCNM) and the Boucher Institute of Naturopathic Medicine (BINM) merged into a single, combined naturopathic institution under the name Canadian College of Naturopathic Medicine. The merged institution offers ND programs at both the CCNM campus in Toronto, Ontario, and at the former BINM campus in New Westminster, British Columbia. Both ND programs are CNME-accredited (note that when it was a separate institution, the BINM ND program was CNME-accredited).

Initial CNME accreditation was granted to CCNM in September 2000 and last reaffirmed in May 2020. The next full-scale evaluation is scheduled for winter 2027, with a decision on continued accreditation to be made in spring 2028. The college is recognized by all Canadian provinces that regulate naturopathic doctors and its graduates are also licensable in the U.S. states that license naturopathic doctors.

Initial CNME accreditation was granted in January 2021, retroactive to May 2020, for a period of four years. Since the evaluation visit for initial accreditation was conducted virtually due to COVID-19 related impediments, the CNME conducted a follow-up, interim onsite visit in the spring of 2023. The next comprehensive evaluation visit for reaccreditation is scheduled for April of 2024 with a decision on continued accreditation to be made at the spring 2024 Council meeting.
